## **Community Infrastructure Levy: Gosport Draft Charging Schedule**

## Statement on Issues and Questions

Question 12: Given that hotel and industrial developments place demands on local infrastructure, does the evidence justify the proposed nil rate for these types of development?

Date: 23<sup>rd</sup> February 2015



- 1. Whilst it is recognised that all forms of development put demands on local infrastructure, CIL Guidance<sup>1</sup> only permits the making of a CIL charge where it can be demonstrated that the charge does not threaten the ability to develop viably.
- 2. The results of the viability studies for hotel and industrial development in CIL 5 (document CIL 5- Page 67, paragraph C9.2 & Page 75, paragraph C9.4) have shown that these categories of development are not currently sufficiently financially viable to be able to support a CIL charge. If and when the market improves and values increase, there is the potential to review the situation.
