Positively prepared - the plan should be prepared based on a strategy which seeks to meet objectively assessed development and infrastructure requirements, including unmet requirements from neighbouring authorities where it is reasonable to do so and consistent with achieving sustainable development;

Justified - the plan should be the most appropriate strategy, when considered against the reasonable alternatives, based on proportionate evidence;

Effective - the plan should be deliverable over its period and based on effective joint working on cross boundary strategic priorities; and

Consistent with National policy - the plan should enable the delivery of sustainable development in accordance with the policies in the Framework.

	The third Regeneration Area, Haslar Peninsula, is of great historic significance, as recognised in paragraphs 7.101, 7.102, 7.121 and 7.139. English Heritage therefore welcomes and supports general principle 1a), the second caveat in Royal Hospital principle 2e), principles 3a) and 3b) and the caveats in Blockhouse principles 4b) and c) i) of Policy LP6: Haslar Peninsula, as part of the positive strategy for the conservation and enjoyment of, and clear strategy for enhancing, the historic environment required in local plans by paragraphs 126 and 157 of the National Planning Policy Framework. We also welcome and support the supporting paragraphs 7.102, 7.131, 7.133, 7.134,7.135, 7.142, 7.144, 7.146, 7.148 and 7.151 as also contributing to those positive and clear strategies.
	However, as with the Waterfront, Town Centre and Daedalus, whilst we would hope that the rigorous application of these principles would ensure that the historical significance of the Haslar Peninsula is indeed conserved and enhanced, and that significance better revealed, by any proposed development, our tacit acceptance of this policy must be without prejudice to any comments we may wish to make when detailed proposals come forward.
