Early C19, on corner of Forton Road. Three-storeys, dropping to 2 on Forton Road frontage. Three windows. Slate roof and inter-locking tile, hipped on corner, brick eaves band with coupled dentils. Yellow brickwork in Flemish bond, (painted at north end and return) flat arches. Sashes; to south a 2-storeyed bay, to right bay on first and second floor. Corner with Forton Road comprises an elaborate pub front, with coarse classical pilastered treatment; cast iron columns giving intermediate support to the 2 and 3-light windows, panelled dado, plinth, entrance on corner angle.
