

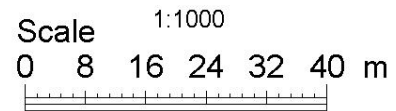
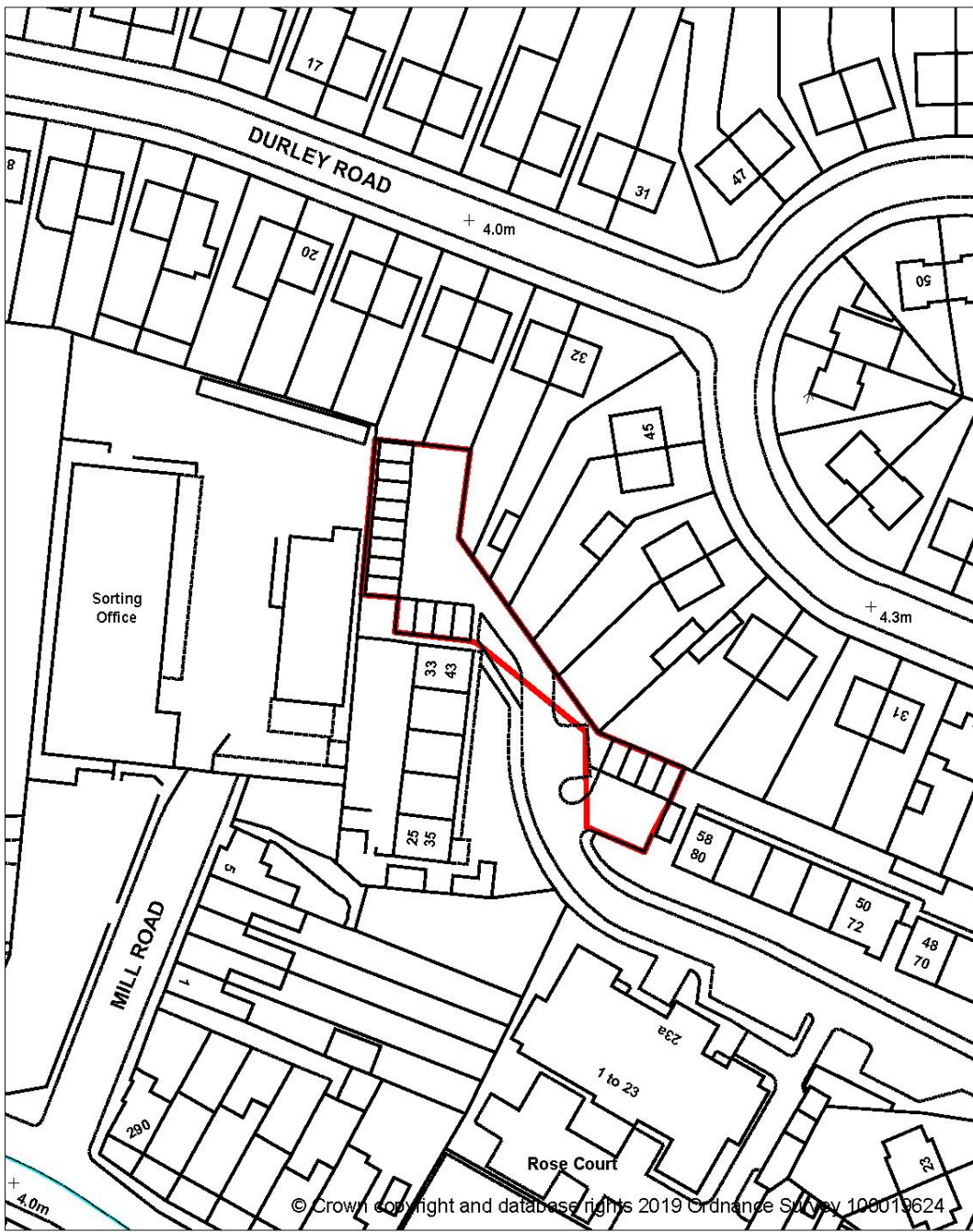

Concluding comments	The sites small size limits the level of development achievable on the site. Development would have to meet the existing parking need and provide parking for new development. Site could be part of comprehensive redevelopment with neighbouring Solent Building Supplies and Post Office.
Concluding actions	Site would fall under threshold if developed alone. Could be part of wider redevelopment with adjacent sites.
